Oil crept higher on Monday, but gave up big early gains as optimism over major crude producers' deal to extend record output cuts gave way to disappointment that the accord didn't extend beyond the end of July.

Since the start of April Brent has nearly doubled,
propped up by the unprecedented production cut of 9.7
million barrels per day — nearly 10% of global supplies

he potential return of Libyan output could also cause considerable challenges for the OPEC leadership

Brent crude had climbed as high as \$43.41 a barrel but later was trading up just 13 cents, or 0.3%, at \$42.43

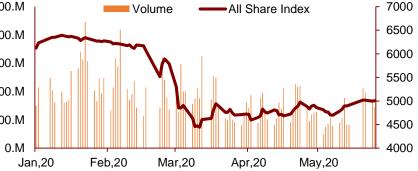
